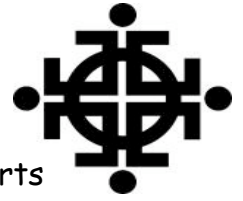


Session 28: *The Covenant Church is Formed*

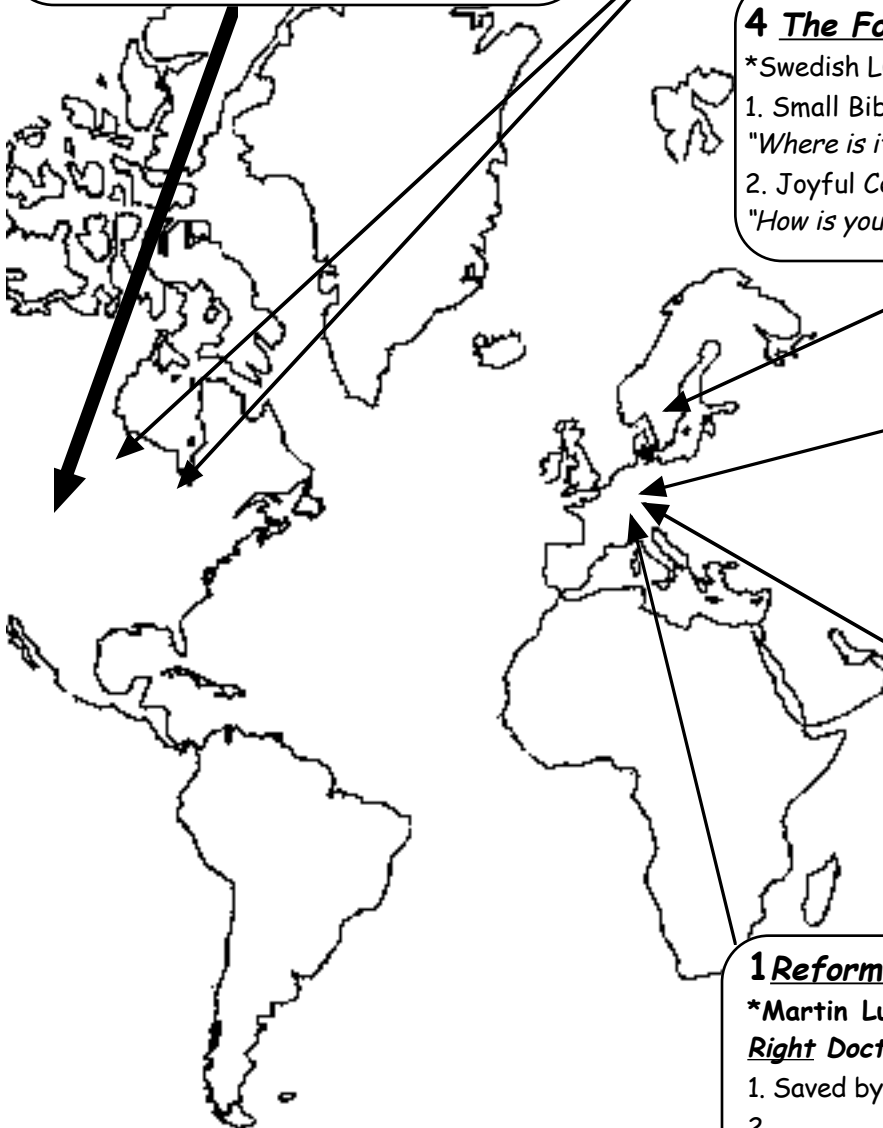
