All applications must be completed and postmarked by one of the following pre-designated dates: February 15, April 1, June 1, August 1, October 1, and December 1. These are the dates that application reviews will begin.

It is expected that all applications will be turned in <u>at least 8 weeks</u> in advance of the expected start date for the Spiritual Direction training for which the grant will be used. For example, if the program is to begin on June 7, the application would need to be submitted by the pre-designated date of April 1.

A response will be given to all applicants within a 21 day period after the pre-designated deadline.
