Our Purpose

The purpose of the Association of Covenant Spiritual Directors (ACSD) is to further the spiritual direction ministry of the ECC by providing visibility for the ministry, advocacy to strengthen and expand the ministry, support for affiliated spiritual directors, and coordination of shared ministries and resourcing with regional spiritual direction networks.

We offer the ministry of spiritual direction at various Covenant events such as the Midwinter Conference, Women's Triennial, Sustaining Pastoral Excellence events, and Covenant Orientation classes.

Support

Membership

Membership in the Association of Covenant Spiritual Directors is granted to those who support the purposes of the ACSD and are committed to the criteria and standards of the Association. Full Membership

Full membership is open to any spiritual director who is a graduate of an approved spiritual direction program and who is a member of an Evangelical Covenant Church. Full members have voting privileges.

Associate Membership

Associate membership is open to any Covenantaffiliated spiritual director who is a graduate of an approved spiritual direction program but not a member of a Covenant church.

Student Membership

Student membership in the Association is open to Covenant-affiliated students preparing for spiritual direction ministry through enrollment in a spiritual direction certification or degree program recognized by the ACSD.



Application

Make application to the ACSD by downloading and completing the appropriate application found at CovChurch.org/acsd.

Initial Membership: Initial membership whether full, associate, or student is granted upon the applicant meeting the standards and criteria established by the ACSD, including payment of dues.

Annual Dues:	Full Membership	\$20
	Associate Membership	\$15
	Student Membership	\$10

Annual Membership: Annual renewal of membership for any class of members will be granted upon meeting criteria for continued participation as determined by the ACSD and upon payment of the membership dues. Membership is from the ACSD's annual meeting to annual meeting.

The purpose of spiritual direction networks in the various ECC regional conferences is to offer a gift of listening, discernment, and prayer in a confidential setting of encouragement and compassion to the pastors, ministry staff, missionaries, and their spouses in their conferences. Some conference networks also serve laity as part of their mission and ministry. Through the networks, individuals may connect with a spiritual director who will listen to the stories of their lives and help discern the presence and work of the Holy Spirit.
